
#### **Helpful Tips**

- ❖ Make sure page 5 (alumni), Part III: Areas of Achievement or page 9 (undergraduate only) Part IV: Areas of Achievement is the fourth page of the submitted Chapter of the Year Award Petition. Chapters can use as many pages as deem necessary to give unique and creative style to the responses of the petition questions.

The postmarked deadline for all packages to be in compliance of the rule will be Friday, March 15, 2024. NO EXECPTIONS!

Nothing in lieu of a paper copy of the petition application will be accepted. Meaning, no electronic copies, no video recording, and no email copies will be accepted by the Southern Province Achievement Committee members.

## 2024 Undergraduate Chapter of the Year Petition

## **Petition Instructions**

The Southern Province Undergraduate Chapter of the Year Award is the highest award available to undergraduate chapters for outstanding achievement. The undergraduate chapters nominated must have at least <u>seven (7) members</u> who are in "Good Standing" with the undergraduate chapter, Province, and Grand Chapter.

- A.) A chapter with at least <u>7 but not more than 20 members</u> in good standing with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **small chapter** category;
- B.) A chapter with at least 21 but not more than 30 members in good standing with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the medium chapter category;
- C.) A chapter with <u>more than 30 members</u> in good standing with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **large chapter** category.

The total number of members in "Good Standing" reported by the chapter will be verified by the Southern Province Achievement Committee by contacting IHQ to verify accuracy.

Petitions for the alumni chapter of the year award must be typed and submitted on a standard petition application from KappaOrg.com. The completed petition form must be postmarked by the deadline of March 15, 2024. NO EXCEPTIONS!

- A) Send one (1) copy to the Achievement Committee Chairman
- B) Send one (1) copy to each member of the Achievement Committee

A mailing list of Southern Province Achievement Committee members is included with the Chairman's Letter, and the contact list will be posted on the Southern Province Website.

The completed petition application must be supported with documentation. The documentation may include official letters, printed programs, brochures, newspaper articles, pictures, **none of which will be returned.** 

## The petition is divided into four (4) parts:

PART I – Background is general information that provides basic background information about the chapter.

PART II – College/University Certification certifies that the chapter and the undergraduates are in "Good Standing" with the institution. This section must be completed and signed by an official of the college or university.

PART III – Province Certification certifies that the chapter is in "Good Standing" with the Province. This section must be completed and sign by the Southern Province Polemarch, Southern Province Keeper of Exchequer, and Southern Province Keeper of Records. This form will be available upon request from the Province Director of Operations after verification of being compliant with all Grand Chapter and Provice Requirements


PART IV – Areas of Achievement indicates the areas for which the chapter's outstanding achievement will be considered. Convincing statements should be made to support the various areas.

- **5.** Describe the Chapter's involvement with programs of goals announced by the Grand Chapter and Province Council (include names of programs/goals) (20 points).
- **6.** Describe the Chapter's involvement within the community. Identify activities under the following headings: a) political action; b) social action; c) scholarship support; d) community service; and e) contributions to charitable and non-profit organizations (15 points).
- 7. Describe the Chapter's involvement in improving the quality of college/university life at your institution. Describe the perception of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity on your campus, the Chapter's involvement in college/university clubs or organizations. Name Brothers in campus leadership positions, offices held and their roles (10 points).
- **8.** Describe any Chapter events that have involved a collaboration between your chapter and at least 1 other chapter in the Province (10 points).
- **9.** Give the names of the Chapter Brothers who hold an elective or appointed office or committee membership at the Province or Grand Chapter level (5 points).
