2025-2026 Alumni Community Service Chapter of the Year Petition

Petition Instructions

The Southern Province Alumni Chapter Community Service Award is the highest award available to alumni chapters for outstanding community service. The alumni chapters submitting must have at least **ten (10) members** who are in “**Good Standing**” with the Grand Chapter, Southern Province, and alumni chapter.

- A) A chapter with at least **10 but not more than 30 members** in “Good Standing” with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **small chapter** category.
- B) A chapter with at least **31 but not more than 60 members** in “Good Standing” with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **medium chapter** category.
- C) A chapter with more than **60 members but not more than 120 members** in good standing with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **large chapter** category.
- D) A chapter with **more than 120 members** in good standing with the Fraternity at the Grand Chapter, Province and chapter levels is in the **extra-large chapter** category.

The total number of members in “Good Standing” reported by the chapter will be verified by the Southern Province Achievement Committee by contacting IHQ to verify accuracy.

Petitions for the alumni community service chapter of the year award must be typed and submitted on a standard petition application from Southern Province website. The completed petition application must be emailed by the deadline of **February 28, 2026 at midnight.**

- A) Email electronic version (i.e. Flipping book, PDF, or MS Project) to all members of the Achievement Committee.
- B) One (1) hardcopy will be sent to the Achievement Committee Chairman, for archiving, after the winner is selected at Province Council.

A list of Southern Province Achievement Committee members is included with the Chairman’s Letter also located on the Southern Province website. The completed petition application must be supported with documentation. The documentation may include official letters, printed programs, brochures, newspaper articles or pictures.


